Examples noted of excessive or unnecessary costs in housing:

- local Council charging the adjacent common drainage work against the house building consent costs
- double framed external timber walls 90 wide structural and 20 wide strapping for cladding
- use of sealed building wrap instead of breather type building paper with unsealed laps
- over-insulated housing in the temperate zones
- excessive use of heat pumps
- double glazing not necessary in temperate zones use of a dehumidifier eliminates window condensation
- forced air ventilation systems in roof space are not necessary if the ceiling insulation is adequate and properly laid are these systems healthy?
- encourage designers to again include <u>fanlights</u> for passive cross ventilation cost effective when compared with full height sliders etc
